ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUND

ABDOMEN COMPLETE, GALLBLADDER, LIVER, PANCREAS, SPLEEN

WHAT TO EXPECT

In an Abdominal Ultrasound, a transducer (probe) will be placed onto your skin. A layer of warm gel will be applied directly onto the skin allowing sound waves to be transmitted from the transducer through the gel and into the body. You may be asked to hold your breath for some of the images. If you are experiencing pain at the time of your examination, it may be uncomfortable due to the technologist applying pressure with the transducer. If you experience any pain during the exam please let the technologist know. Expect this exam to take approximately 45 minutes.

PATIENT PREP

BEFORE YOUR EXAM

Please be sure you have nothing to eat or drink 6 hours prior to your examination time. You may have a small sip of water to take any medications.

Please wear loose clothing as you will have to expose your abdomen for this exam.
