BREAST ASPIRATION

WHAT TO EXPECT

In an Ultrasound Guided Breast Aspiration the Radiologist will use the Ultrasound machine to detect the lesion to be Aspirated. He will use a very small needle to numb the skin with Lidocaine (numbing medicine). Once the area is numb he will make a small incision the size of your pinky nail. He will then insert a needle into the lesion using the ultrasound to see the location of the Needle. If the lesion is able to be aspirated successfully the procedure will be complete. If the lesion is not able to be aspirated you may need an Ultrasound Guided Needle Biopsy. If the fluid the Radiologist aspirates appears abnormal the fluid will be sent to Ameripath Laboratory in Indianapolis to be viewed by a pathologist. You will be given discharge instructions to follow for the aftercare bandaging. The ordering Provider and the Radiologist will receive the results typically in 5-7 business days. Once the results are received, the radiologist will call you regardless of the results. He will not leave the results on a Voicemail, but may leave a message to call him back.

PATIENT PREP

BEFORE YOUR EXAM

Do not wear any deodorant, lotions, or powders the day of your examination.

If you are on any blood thinners including baby aspirin or maintenance ibuprofen please hold these for 24 hours prior to your exam. ****Please be sure to check with the Dr. who prescribes this medication before holding****
