BREAST

WHAT TO EXPECT

In a Breast Ultrasound, a transducer (probe) will be placed onto your skin. A layer of warm gel will be applied directly onto the skin allowing sound waves to be transmitted from the transducer through the gel and into the body. Ultrasound can help to look for breast changes, skin changes, or lumps. It can also be used to look at changes seen on a mammogram. You will be required to undress from the waist up and wear a caped gown. The Radiologist will then scan the breast in the area of interest and take multiple images.

Do not wear any deodorant, lotions, or powders the day of your examination.
