PELVIC NON-OB

WHAT TO EXPECT

In a Pelvic Ultrasound, a transducer (probe) will be placed onto your skin. A layer of warm gel will be applied directly onto the skin allowing sound waves to be transmitted from the transducer through the gel and into the body. Depending on how detailed your images are from the transabdominal pelvic scan, you may have to have an internal or vaginal Ultrasound. It looks at the pelvic organs from inside the vagina using a vaginal transducer (probe). This is similar to an internal pelvic exam or PAP smear.

PATIENT PREP

BEFORE YOUR EXAM

Please come to your exam with a full bladder. You must drink 32oz of water 1 hour prior to your examination.
