## PREGNANCY

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### WHAT TO EXPECT

In a Pregnancy Ultrasound, a transducer (probe) will be placed onto your skin. A layer of warm gel will be applied directly onto the skin allowing sound waves to be transmitted from the transducer through the gel and into the body. Depending on how far along you are, you may have to have an internal or vaginal Ultrasound. The vaginal ultrasound looks at the pelvic organs and baby from inside the vagina using a vaginal transducer (probe). This is similar to an internal pelvic exam or PAP smear.

## PATIENT PREP

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### BEFORE YOUR EXAM

Please come to your exam with a full bladder. You must drink 32oz of water 1 hour prior to your examination.
