THYROID

WHAT TO EXPECT

In a Thyroid Ultrasound, a transducer (probe) will be placed onto your skin. A layer of warm gel will be applied directly onto the skin allowing sound waves to be transmitted from the transducer through the gel and into the body. You may have to remove any sweatshirts, sweaters, t-shirts or necklaces and place a gown on. The technologist will take images from your neck up to your ear. If you are experiencing pain at the time of your examination, it may be uncomfortable due to the technologist applying pressure with the transducer. If you experience any pain during the exam please let the technologist know. Expect this exam to take approximately 30-45 minutes.

PATIENT PREP

BEFORE YOUR EXAM

Please wear loose and/or low cut clothing to expose your neck for the Carotid Doppler. Avoid collared or cowl neck tops to avoid changing into a gown. Try to avoid wearing any jewelry on your neck to your examination
