RETROPERITONEAL

WHAT TO EXPECT

In a Retroperitoneal Ultrasound, a transducer (probe) will be placed onto your skin. A layer of warm gel will be applied directly onto the skin allowing sound waves to be transmitted from the transducer through the gel and into the body. You may be asked to hold your breath for some of the images. If you are experiencing pain at the time of your examination, it may be uncomfortable due to the technologist applying pressure with the transducer. If at any time during the examination you feel like you need to urinate or experience any pain, please let the technologist know. Expect this exam to take approximately 45 minutes.

PATIENT PREP

BEFORE YOUR EXAM

Nothing to eat 6 hours prior to your exam. Please come to your exam with a full bladder. You must drink 32oz of water 1 hour prior to your examination.
