MRI WITH CONTRAST

WHAT TO EXPECT

Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) is a radiological method of looking inside the body without the use of x rays. You will be asked to lie down on a table and get comfortable. The table will then move you into a tunnel and the machine will obtain the necessary images. The test usually takes about 45 minutes to an hour.

MRI's are very noisy. The noise is due to the vibration in the machine. Ear plugs along with headphones for music will be provided for your comfort.

You will be asked to change into a gown and scrub pants provided by the hospital. No jewelry should be worn and all keys, coins, credit cards, dentures, eyeglasses, etc. must be removed. A locker will be provided for your belongings.

Approximately half way through your exam you will be given a small amount of contrast through a vein. Therefore, we will start an IV prior to the procedure.
